# MIET Student Teams Win First Prize of Rs. 1 Lakh each at Smart India Hackathon 2022

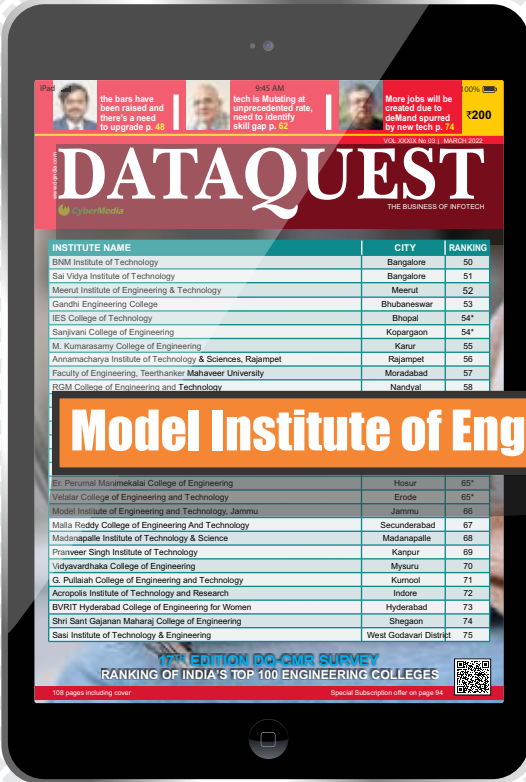
Two teams from Model Institute of Engineering and Technology (Autonomous) won the First Prize at the Grand Finale of the Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2022 organized by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, between 25-26 Aug 2022. Both the teams were awarded with a cash prize of Rs. 1 Lakh each and emerged winners in their respective problem domains. The first winning team named “DSC” was led by Ms. Dhvani Gupta from CSE at the designated nodal centre at Coimbatore. The team developed an app for screening the possible mental health issues in adolescents and persons-with-disabilities, using conversational AI and emotion de-

Team “Smile” worked on an app for well-being surveillance, assessment and tracking of children using a virtual cartoon character to interact with children and using AI to determine overall well-being. Other team members were Lavanya Sharma, Archit Prasar, Ananya Gupta, Tanisha Gandhi and Ratinder Pal Singh along with Assistant Prof. Arjun Puri from the CSE department.

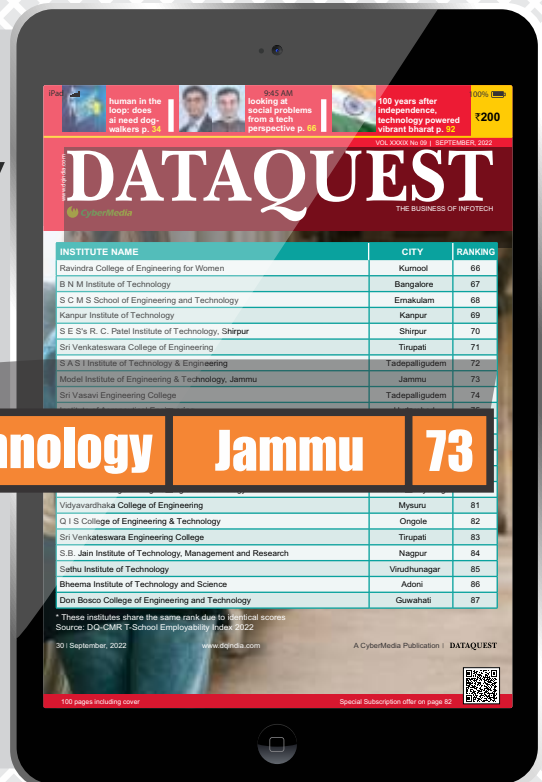

# CSE Department Re-accredited by NBA from 2022-2025

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering at MIET was re-accredited by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) for a period of 3 years, 2022-2025. The re-accreditation process of the NBA is a comprehensive process that includes a review of the institution's programs, educational outcomes, facilities, and governance. This re-accreditation makes

CSE program at MIET the only accredited program in the entire UT of J&K across all universities and colleges. This is the third time the CSE department has been successfully accredited by the NBA. This accreditation is a recognition of the commitment of the CSE department to offer high quality education leading to attainment of specified outcomes. The department

has recently undertaken a massive transformation program resulting in new infrastructure, lab upgradation and cloud-based laboratories, curriculum revision, project-based learning, introduction of minor specializations and access to unlimited skilling through a tie-up with Coursera. Many of these initiatives are the first-of-their-kind in J&K.







## BBA-LLB (Hons.)

First Integrated Management & Law Honors Program in J&K with approval of the Bar Council of India (BCI)

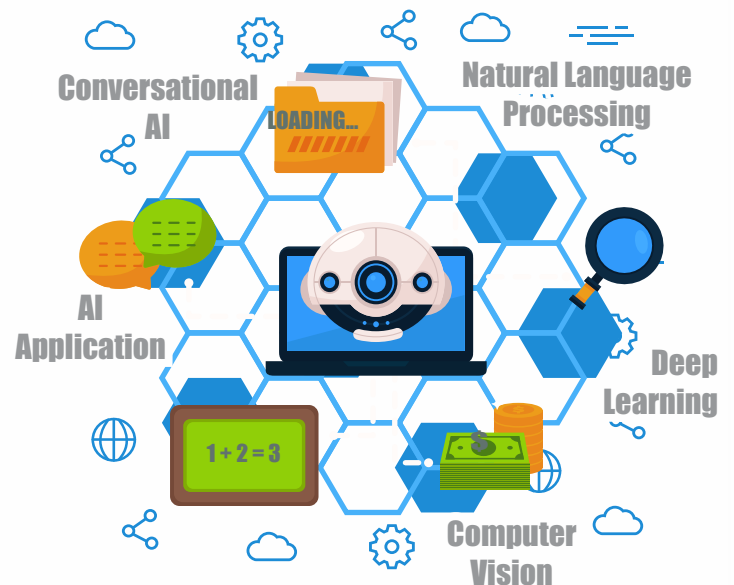
The MIET School of Law commenced operations by starting the BBA-LLB (Hons.) course after receiving the approval from the Bar Council of India from the session 2022-23 with an intake of 120 students. The BBA-LLB (Hons.) is an integrated course offering students exposure to the law and management domains with a provision to obtain specializations in specific areas. Such a program is not available in J&K and thus it fulfills a major gap in the educational offerings to the students of the region. Prof. Sunita Zalpuri Koul, former Dean, Institute of Management and Public Administration, Govt. of J&K, has been appointed as the Founding Dean of the MIET School of Law and highly qualified faculty members have been recruited to offer a highly flexible and modern curriculum to the students.

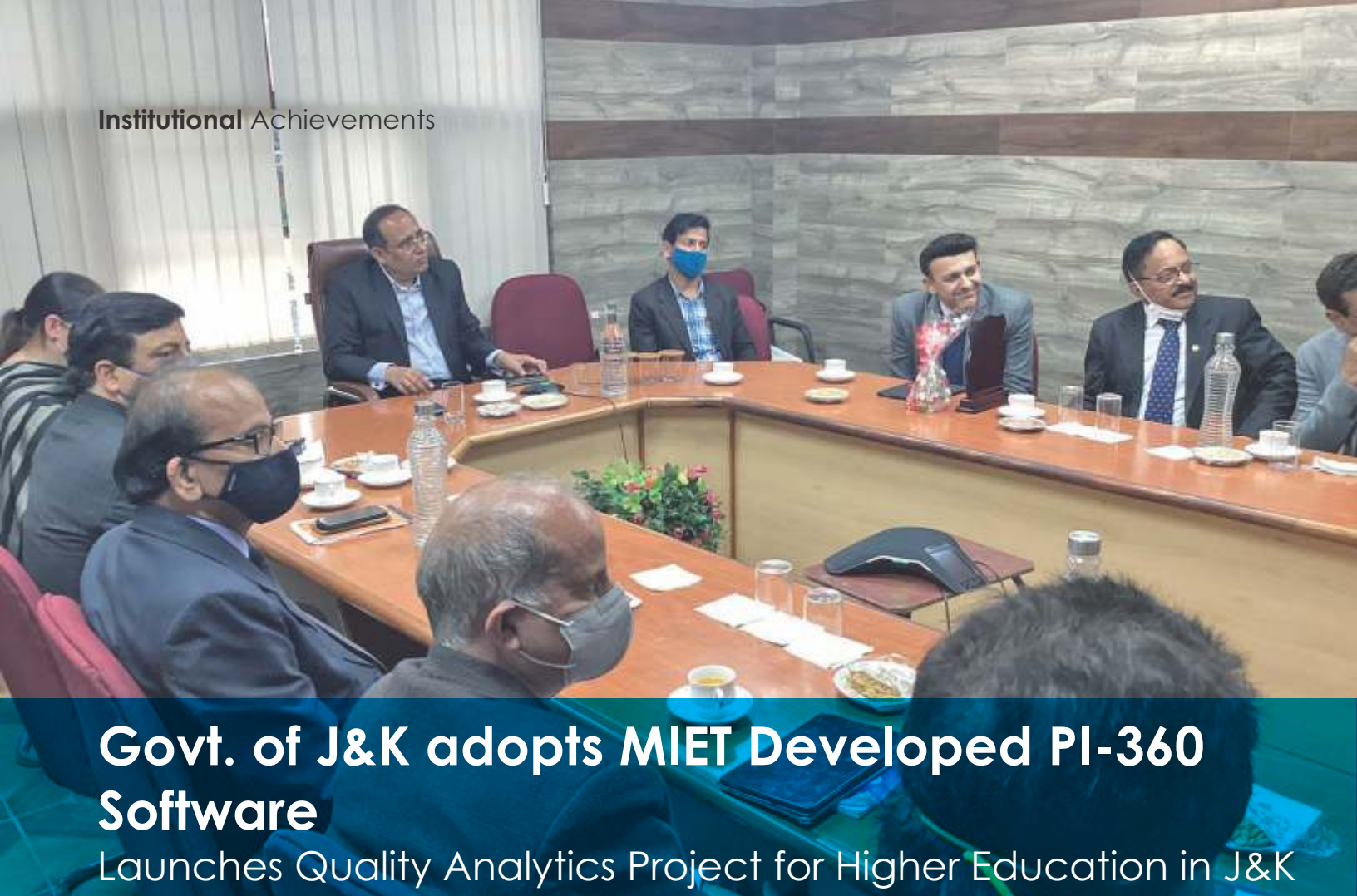

## B.E Computer Science & Engineering (AI & ML)

The Bachelor of Engineering (B.E) Computer Science and Engineering, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning program commenced with an intake of 60 students from 2022-23 with due approval from the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). This program is designed to provide students with an opportunity to excel in the field of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning which is dominating the technology landscape. This program is an outcome of the commitment of the Academic Council of MIET to start programs which are novel and future focused. It is pertinent to mention that a B.E Computer Science and Engineering AI and ML program is not available at any other institution in the region at present.





# Govt. of J&K adopts MIET Developed PI-360 Software

## Launches Quality Analytics Project for Higher Education in J&K

In a landmark move, MIET developed quality analytics framework, Performance Insight 360 (PI-360), recipient of the Quality Council of India's (QCI) D.L Shaw Platinum Award, was adopted by the Govt. of J&K to manage quality across eleven marquee institutions spanning 25,000 students and over 2000 faculty members. The software was launched by Principal Secretary, Higher Education, JK UT, Mr. Rohit Kansal at a glittering event at GCW, Parade on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2022. Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Kansal outlined the vision of the JK UT Administration to usher in innovative and path-breaking reforms in the higher education sector including automation of quality assurance. He explained that the Performance Insight 360

framework will help higher education colleges adopt a data-driven approach, by capturing and analyzing data related to outcomes of the institution as required by accreditation and regulatory bodies. This is the first time in India that a State or UT Govt is employing cloud-based analytics-as-a-service model to track and improve performance and quality outcomes of its higher education institutions. Mr. Kansal expressed hope that after the success of the pilot program, it will be rolled out to cover additional institutions in a phased manner. As part of the project MIET trained faculty members and principals of eleven colleges including GCET Jammu, GCW Parade, GCW Gandhi Nagar, GGM Science College, GDC Kathua, GDC Reasi, etc.







## MoU with Center for Global Management California State University San Bernardino, USA

MIET School of Management signed an international MoU with the Center for Global Management, Jack H. Brown School of Management at the California State University, San

Bernardino, USA. Prof. Vipin Gupta, Co-Director, Center for Global Management and Professor at the Jack H. Brown School of Management visited the MIET Campus and signed the

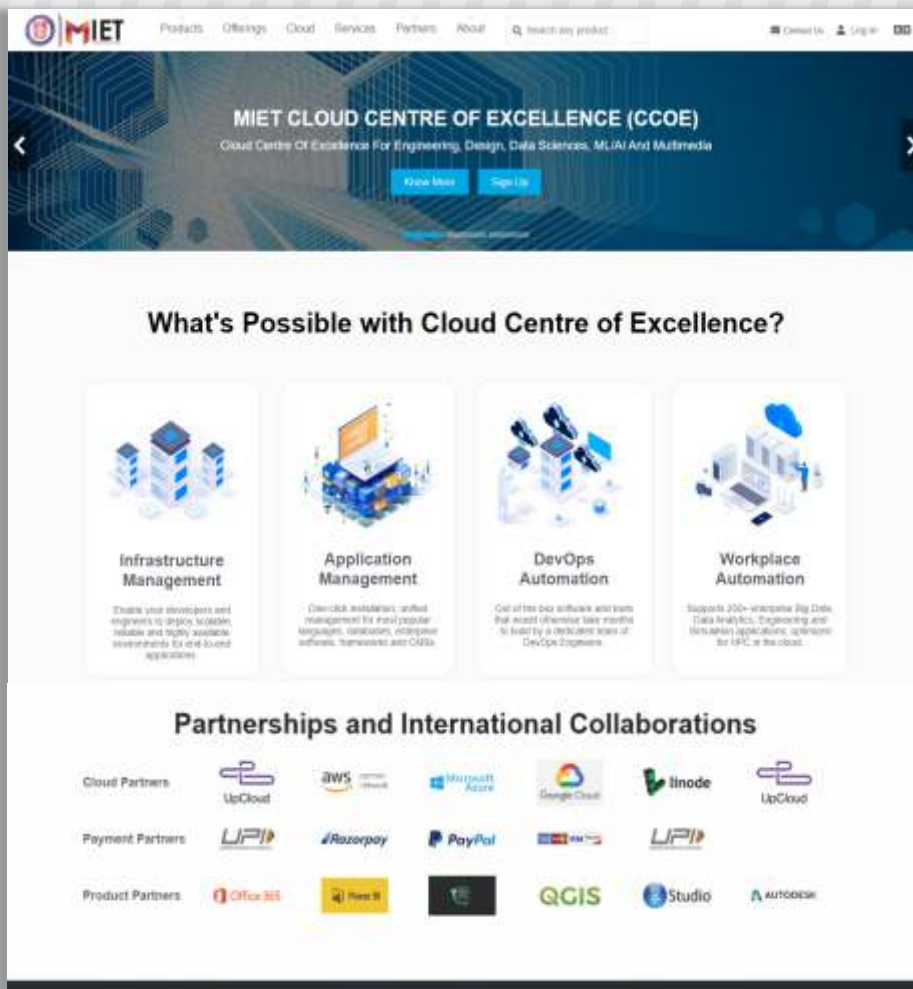
# NebulaCloud PLATFORM

MIET partnered with the Nebula Cloud platform, to enable students and faculty members to access computing facilities and labs from anywhere. The Nebula Cloud platform provides basic computing facilities and also

High Performance Computing (HPC) and cloud resources, all in one place. This will enable users to run compute and data-intensive workloads for Artificial Intelligence and data-science related applications. The platform comes pre-loaded with

all the software for specific labs and users just need to select the computing configuration required and launch the virtual machine. Run-time services can also be provisioned on the platform giving the required flexibility to the users.



## CCOE at MIET (Cloud Centre of Excellence)

Besides the Lab Access, MIET has set up the Cloud Centre of Excellence (CCoE). The CCoE is a centralized enterprise architecture function that champions the cloud computing adoption within MIET. It will provide access to cloud-based technology to the students and faculty, besides lowering the total cost of ownership of HPC resources for MIET. The CCoE has enabled a cloud-native future for MIET with a modern and agile IT infrastructure. All the MIET IT systems run off the cloud now, with no on-premise deployments.

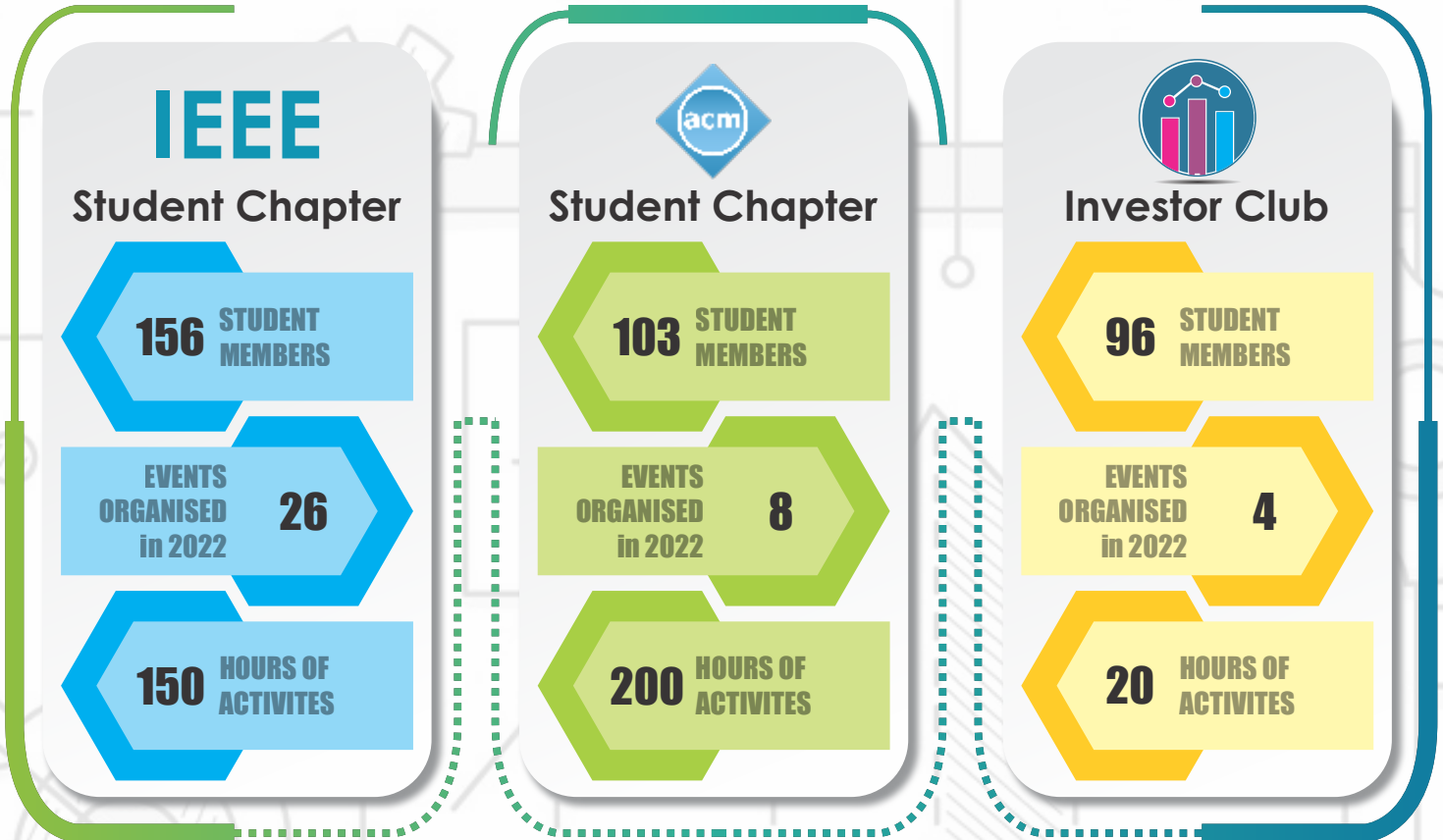
## Technology-Enabled Learning (TEL) Policy

# Green Initiatives @ MIET

## Rainwater Harvesting

Phase-I of the Rainwater Harvesting project has been completed at MIET. Completed under a Seed Grant to the Civil Engineering department, it uses specialized rainwater filters for filtering roof-top rainwater. Currently 16,000 liters of filtered rainwater can be stored and utilized. The vision is to harvest and store 1 Lakh liters of filtered rainwater over the next 2 years. The entire project was executed by the college engineering support team along with students & faculty.



## Sewage Treatment Plant

MIET in keeping with its commitment to adopting "Green Practices", has installed a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) of 10,000 litres per day capacity. This is the first of its kind STP implementation in any higher education institution in J&K using Japanese Johkasou technology for sewage treatment and reuse, which uses low energy for STP processing. The plant has successfully started generating ample treated water which is being used for watering the gardens & other miscellaneous uses.

## 31<sup>st</sup> Patent Filed

MIET's 31<sup>st</sup> patent filing at the Indian Patent Office is an exciting milestone and indicative of the innovative research and development taking place at the institute. The patent was filed based on work done by student Aadhaar Koul from 5<sup>th</sup> semester, CSE under the Director's Internship program. This work discloses a method for automatic threat detection and mitigation while browsing the web, issuing advisories to prevent potentially unsafe operations. It is a great accomplishment as this system has immense potential to protect non tech-savvy users from making basic mistakes and becoming susceptible to cyber-attacks. A research paper is also in the offing describing a globally coordinated system based on federated learning to provide a shield against cyber-attacks without using complex security software which is out of reach of ordinary users.

Legal Database Lab started operations at the School of Law for both students and faculty. Orientation session for research and overview of Legal Eagle Web an online legal DB software was also organized.

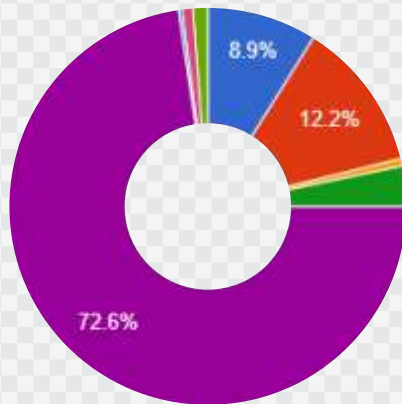

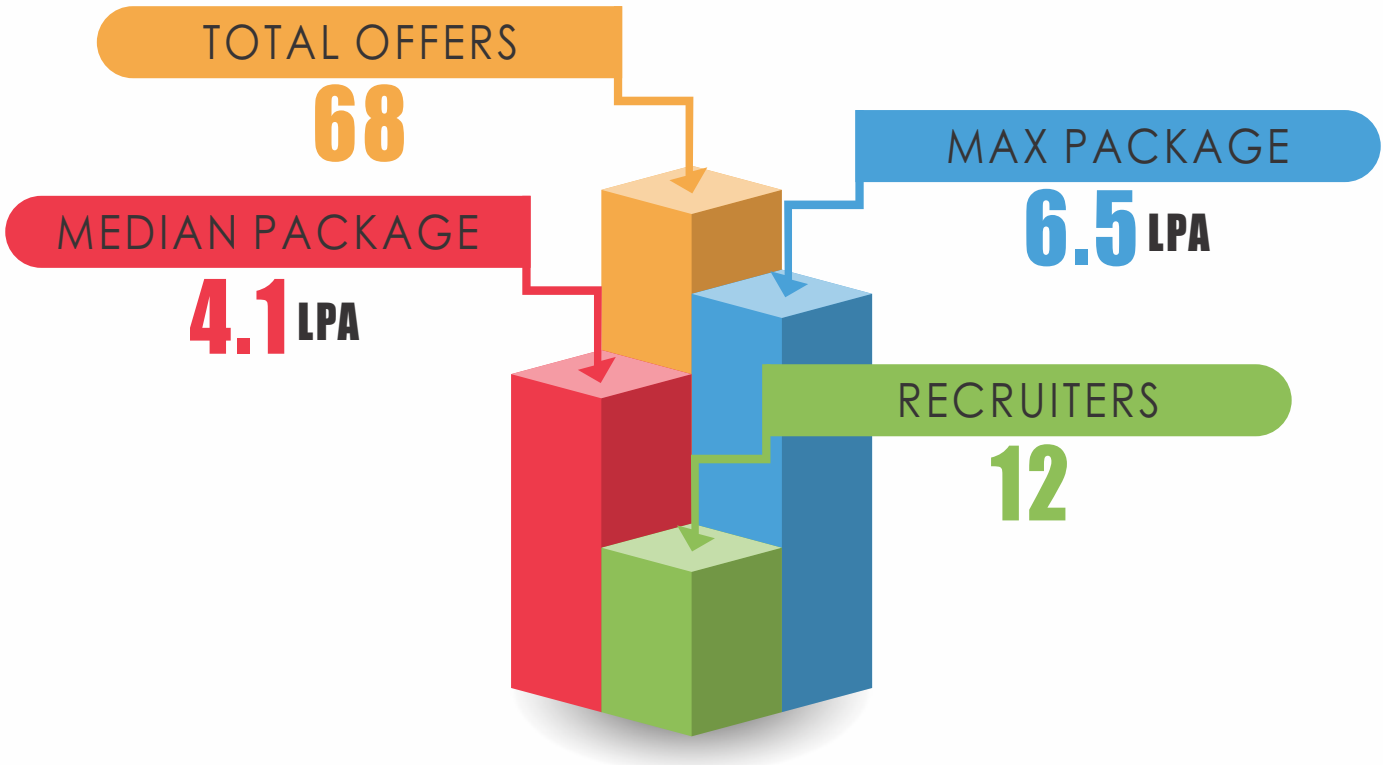
## Clinched 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize in Startup-Idea Event

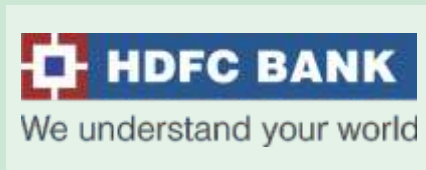
